CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER-FORFEITURE (4519)

- 1. That no Claimant has appeared or filed an answer pursuant to 725 ILCS 150/9 (D). That Plaintiff gave notice of these proceedings to all Claimants of which it has knowledge. That the 45 day time in which Claimants have to appear and answer does not expire until \_\_\_\_/\_\_\_\_/\_\_\_\_.
