ADULT PROBATION SEX OFFENDER PROGRAM CONDITIONS

IT IS THE FINDING OF THE COURT THAT:

The Defendant is a "sex offender" as defined under 730 ILCS 150/2(A); and as such is required by Illinois Law to comply with the following conditions:

1. All requirements of the Sex Offender Registration Act apply to a registrant for the duration of his/her duty to register. Sex offenders shall register in person and provide accurate information required by the Illinois State Police. The sex offender shall register with the Chief of Police in the municipality in which he or she resides/temporarily domiciled or the designated Chicago Police Department, or County Sheriff, and Chief of Police in the municipality in which he or she is employed in an institution of higher education or with the public safety or security director of the institution of higher education in which he or she is employed/attends within three (3) days of sentence to probation and release from incarceration and within three (3) days of any change of address. If the sex offender lacks a fixed residence, he or she must report weekly with the Chief of Police in the municipality or the Sheriff's office of the unincorporated area in which he or she is located (720 ILCS 5/150-3) (Failure to register accordingly is a Class 3 Felony.)
2. Under 730 ILCS 5/5-4-3, unless DNA was previously provided, the sex offender shall submit a DNA specimen to be placed into the State or national DNA database, to be used in accordance with provisions of the Act.
3. Under 730 ILCS 5/5-6-3(a), in addition to all other conditions of probation, the sex offender
  - Shall undergo and successfully complete sex offender treatment at a counseling program.
  - Shall refrain from residing with another convicted sex offender.
  - If qualified as a child sex offender, shall refrain from communicating with or contacting over the internet anyone under age 18 who is not related to the offender.
  - For specific offenses 11-6, 11-9.1, 11-14.4 that involves soliciting for a sexually exploited child, 11-15.1, 11-20.1, 11-20.1B, 11-20.3, or 11-21 of the Criminal Code of 1961 or the Criminal Code of 2012, or any attempt:
    - Shall refrain from accessing/using a computer or any other device with Internet capability without the prior written approval of the offender's probation officer, except in connection with the offender's employment or search for employment with the prior

- approval of the offender's probation officer.
- Shall submit to monitoring and periodic/unannounced searches of offender's computer or any other device with Internet capability by the offender's probation officer, a law enforcement officer, or assigned computer or information technology specialist, including copying/removal of data and any internal or external peripherals and removal of such information, equipment, or device to conduct a more thorough inspection.
  - Shall submit to the installation on the offender's computer or device with Internet capability, at the offender's expense, of one or more hardware or software systems to monitor the Internet use; and
  - Shall abide by any additional internet restrictions including: \_\_\_\_\_

- Shall refrain from accessing or using a social networking website as defined in Section 17-.05 of the Criminal Code of 2012;
  - Unless offender is a parent of a child under age 18 with no other minors present, shall NOT participate in any holiday event involving children under age 18 (including but not limited to Halloween, Santa Claus, Easter Bunny)
  - Shall NOT use any computer scrub software designed to mask or delete internet browser history
  - Shall refrain from any contact, directly or indirectly, with any persons specified by the court:

**4. Under 720 ILCS 5/11-9.3: Child Sex Offender Restrictions**

Failure to comply with any subsection in this statute may result in a Class 4 felony. These Illinois restrictions apply to all child sex offenders for his/her natural life, no matter the length of the registration. "Minor" means any child under 18 years of age.

- Unlawful to be present on any school property when minors are present without permission from and prior notification to appropriate school official superintendent or the school board or in the case of a private school from the principal. While present at the property when minors are present, the sex offender must remain under the direct supervision of a school official.
- Unlawful to be present within 100 feet of a site posted as a pick-up/discharge stop for a school used to transport students to or from school or a school related activity when minors are present.
- Unlawful to be present in any public park building, a playground or recreation area within any publicly accessible privately owned building, or on real property comprising any public park when minors are present in the building or on the grounds and to approach, contact, or communicate with a child under 18 years of age, unless the offender is a parent or guardian of a person minor present in the building or on the grounds.
- Unless specifically excepted under (b) or (b-2), unlawful to loiter within 500 feet of any school building (preschool through high school), property line to property line, within 500 feet of a public park building or real property comprising any public park;
- Unlawful to reside within 500 feet of any school building (preschool through high school), property line to property line.

- Unlawful to reside within 500 feet of a playground, child care institution, day care center, part day child care facility, day care home, group day care home, or a facility providing programs or services exclusively directed towards minors
- Unlawful to reside within 500 feet of the victim until victim is age 21 or older.
- Unlawful to knowingly communicate, other than for a lawful purpose, using the Internet or any other digital media, with a minor.
- Unlawful to knowingly operate, manage, be employed by, volunteer, be associated with or knowingly be present at any facility providing programs/services exclusively directed toward minors, full/part-time/home/group day care center, child care institutions, before/after school programs
- Unlawful to participate in holiday events, carnivals, amusement enterprise, fairs involving minors.
- Unlawful to knowingly offer, provide in-home programs/services to minors.
- Unlawful to knowingly operate a vehicle which is specifically designed, constructed or modified and equipped to be used for the retail sale of food or beverages, including but not limited to an ice cream truck; an authorized emergency vehicle; or a rescue vehicle.

**5. Under 720 ILCS 5/11-9.4-1: Sexual predator and child sex offender, presence in a public park**

Failure to comply with any subsection in this statute may result in a Class A misdemeanor or Class 4 felony. These Illinois restrictions apply to both child sex offenders (victim under 18 years of age) and sexual predators (regardless of victim's age) for his/her natural life, no matter the length of the registration.

- Unlawful to knowingly be present in any public park building or on real property comprising any public park (playground, arcade, library, carnival, zoo, theme park)
- Unlawful to knowingly loiter on a public way within 500 feet of a public park building or real property comprising any public park

**THE COURT ORDERS** that in addition to the statutory conditions specified above, the defendant/offender be subject to the following Special Conditions of the Adult Sex Offender Program:

- Shall attend and actively participate in sex offender treatment at a court-approved counseling program, follow all treatment providers' recommendations and be responsible for full/partial payment of treatment.
- Shall submit to searches of his/her person, residence, papers, automobile, internet-enabled devices and/or effects at any time such requests are made by the probation officer and shall consent to the use of anything seized as evidence in a court proceeding.
- Shall submit to polygraph examinations at the direction of the Probation Officer and/or counselor to assist in treatment, planning, and case monitoring .
- Shall be prohibited from using alcohol, marijuana and/or illegal drugs and submit to random breath or specimen analysis.

**(08/11/25) CCCR 0124 D**

- Shall NOT maintain a P.O. Box address while on probation.
- Shall not accept employment or volunteer work, which will be in direct contact with children under age 18 without permission of the court.
- Shall not enter the premises, loiter, work or reside within 500 feet of school yards, parks, playgrounds, arcades, daycares, libraries, theme parks, carnivals, toy stores, zoos or other places primarily used by children under the age of 18.
- Shall not enter or loiter around any adult bookstores or entertainment facilities where sexually explicit materials are sold or shown.
- Shall not be in possession of, or have in his/her residence, any pornography, erotica, and/or sexually explicit materials, visuals and/or audio and shall not access any pornography, erotica or sexually explicit services/materials via the telephone or internet.
- Defendant shall be sentenced to Home Confinement with a curfew established by the Adult Probation Department for the duration of the probation. (Curfew is maintained by electronic bracelet.)
- Shall not reside, initiate, establish or maintain contact with victim or any minor child, including his/her children, under the age of 18, nor attempt to do so except under circumstances approved in advance and in writing by the Court.
- Shall not have internet access except under circumstances approved in advance and in writing by the Probation Officer; shall also have each device with internet access monitored by the Adult Probation Department (APD) through using hardware or software systems at the supervised individual's expense; and shall submit to any other appropriate restrictions imposed by the Probation Officer concerning the supervised individual's use of or access to any device with internet capability.

I acknowledge receipt of this Order and agree to abide by the statutory requirements and conditions. I understand that failure to do so could result in a violation of my probation (with a new sentence up to the maximum penalty for the offense before this Court) and/or a new criminal charge.
