ORDER OF SENTENCE AND COMMITMENT TO
COOK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS (CCDOC)
VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION IMPACT CENTER (VRIC)

This matter coming before this court and the court having jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties hereto and being advised in the premises; **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

1. The above-named defendant has been adjudged guilty of the offense(s) enumerated below.

2. Under 730 ILCS 5/5-8-1.2, the defendant is sentenced to the CCDOC VRIC for an in-custody term of 180 days to be immediately followed by a period of 240 days on the Sheriff’s Electronic Monitoring Program.

3. Defendant shall abide by the terms and conditions of the Sheriff’s program. The Sheriff shall be authorized to impose intermediate sanctions for violations including the temporary removal of Defendant from the program, modification of EM requirements and re-incarceration into any Division of the CCDOC pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/5-6-4 (i) without finding a violation of the sentence. The Sheriff shall notify the Court within twenty-four (24) hours of Defendant’s re-incarceration. The Defendant will be notified upon entering the program of any possible intermediate sanctions that may be imposed and the general conduct that will subject the defendant to those intermediate sanctions.

4. The failure to complete the program for any reason, including the 240-day Electronic Monitoring period, shall be deemed a violation of the county impact incarceration program sentence. The Sheriff shall give notice to the State’s Attorney of the person’s failure to complete the program. The Sheriff shall file a petition for violation of the county impact incarceration sentence with the court and the State’s Attorney may proceed on the petition pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/5-6-4. The court may impose any other sentence that was available under Article 4.5 of Chapter V of 730 ILCS or Section 11-501 of the Illinois Vehicle Code at the time of initial sentencing, except for a sentence of probation or conditional discharge.
