ORDER - ELECTRONIC MONITORING (EM) CONDITIONS AND RULES

The following Conditions and Rules for placement and compliance on the EM Program are to be followed in conjunction with any other Orders regarding your Pre-Trial Release. Your signature establishes that you have received a copy of this Order in open court and you agree to abide by this Order.

You are advised that a violation of these Conditions may result in additional charges by the State, contempt proceedings by the Court, or subject you to incarceration in Cook County Department of Corrections.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

GENERAL RULES:

The Adult Probation Department (APD) operates 2 separate Electronic Monitoring (EM) Programs – one to monitor home detention (24/7 and curfew) and one to monitor individuals charged with certain domestic violence offenses (DV Exclusion Zone Program).

- 1. If placed on the 24/7 or curfew home detention program, you MUST remain inside your approved host site during the designated timeframes on your Order. You are NOT permitted to loiter in common areas of multi-unit buildings, including hallways, lobbies, laundry facilities or mailrooms, during your curfew hours. Permission for movement must be authorized by the judge, through an Order. The Order must specify the days/times/locations you are permitted to participate in work, school, basic activities or any one-time event. Schedule changes MUST be approved by the APD or the Social Services Department (SSD) prior to movement.
2. Once you are fitted with an EM device, you are required to travel directly to the approved host site. You MUST arrive within the timeframe specified by APD/SSD staff.
3. If you are evicted from the approved host site or the host revokes consent for you to be placed there, you MUST notify your APD/SSD Officer immediately.
4. You are NOT permitted to relocate without prior notification and approval from APD/SSD.
5. APD/SSD or the monitoring center may contact you for compliance purposes or device related issues. These calls can be made to your approved host site or your place of employment. They may be made to your phone number on record or via your EM device and may occur at any time. You MUST respond to these calls immediately.
6. Any phone service disruptions or changes made to the phone number you have on file with APD/SSD MUST be reported within 24 hours of these events.
7. APD/SSD Officers SHALL be permitted into your approved host site and to inspect your EM device during your placement. Failure to comply with APD/SSD Officers may

result in a violation, and may result in further prosecution of additional charges, including contempt of court and/or incarceration.

- 8. If you are a registered sex offender, you **MUST** register within 3 days of being placed on EM. If you are a violent offender against youth, you **MUST** register within 5 days of being placed on EM.
- 9. You **MUST** comply with the terms of FOID revocation, if applicable, within 48 hours of being placed on EM (i.e. surrender FOID card and/or any firearms as ordered by the Court).
- 10. You may **NOT** possess or be in the presence of firearms or firearm ammunition.
- 11. *(Check only if drug testing is ordered.)* Consuming or being in the presence of unlawful drugs in any amount is prohibited.

**STRICT VIOLATIONS:**

- 1. Any **criminal activity is strictly prohibited**. Any new arrest is a violation of the EM program and Conditions of Release AND may subject you to incarceration.
- 2. Any attempt to remove; disable; destroy; cut; circumvent the operation of, by shielding, foiling or tampering with the EM device, in any fashion, is a strict violation of this Order and may result in you being prosecuted for the crime of escape.
- 3. It is your responsibility to keep your EM device sufficiently charged at all times. Devices **MUST be charged** for at least 2 consecutive hours per day. An alert to APD/SSD for communication loss due to lack of service is a violation and may result in incarceration.
- 4. EM devices are equipped with a two-way call feature, whereby the monitoring center can communicate with you via the device. You **MUST** respond to all communications. FAILURE to respond may result in further prosecution, arrest and incarceration.
- 5. Failure to report to APD/SSD as required or failure to respond to any communication from the APD/SSD Officer **WITHIN 24 hours** will result in further prosecution, arrest, and/or incarceration.
- 6. **Violation of the DV Exclusion Zone may result in the immediate issue of a warrant, arrest, and/or incarceration.**

***WHEREFORE: I acknowledge that I have received and been admonished of the Conditions of the Cook County Adult Probation Department/EM and/or DV Exclusion Zone program. I agree to comply with the Orders of this Court and understand that a willful violation of the EM program may result in my removal from the program, detention, and subject me to contempt of court or further criminal prosecution under the law.***
