REQUEST FOR RELIEF

I request an Emergency Firearms Restraining Order.

TO PETITIONER: This orders the Respondent to refrain from having in his/her custody or control, purchasing possessing, or receiving additional firearms during this Order. Respondent must also turn over any Firearm Owner’s Identification Card and concealed carry license to local law enforcement.

YOU WILL GO TO COURT TODAY AND A 14-DAY EMERGENCY ORDER MAY BE ENTERED. The Respondent will be notified before your second court date and have the opportunity to be present. The judge will hold a hearing at that time to decide if a 6-Month Firearms Restraining Order will be entered.

I request a Six Month Firearms Restraining Order.

TO PETITIONER: This orders the Respondent to refrain from having in his or her custody or control, purchasing, possessing, or receiving additional firearms during this Order. Respondent must also turn over any FIREARM or Firearm Owner’s Identification Card and concealed carry license to local law enforcement.

NO ORDER WILL BE ENTERED TODAY AND YOU WILL NOT GO TO COURT TODAY. You will get a court date within 30 days of today. The Respondent will be notified ahead of time and have the opportunity to be present. The judge will hold a hearing at that time to decide if a 6-Month Firearms Restraining Order will be entered.

I request that the court order a Search Warrant for any firearms in Respondent’s possession.

TO PETITIONER: In order for this to happen, the court must find that there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent possesses firearms. You must provide that evidence.
