ORDER - CONDITIONS OF PRETRIAL RELEASE

725 ILCS 5/110-2(b), 110-5, 110-10, 110-12

(CR1826) Original (CR1827) Reinstatement (CR1828) Amendment (Modification)
Defendant appeared (CR1821) in person (CR1822) virtually.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

(CR1854) Defendant is released with the following non-discretionary conditions:

- 1. Appear in court to answer the charge as ordered by the Court, until discharged or final order of the Court
2. Submit to the orders and process of the Court
3. Not violate any criminal statute of any jurisdiction
4. File written notice with the clerk of the court within 24 hours after a change of address.

AND

Because Defendant is charged with a forcible felony, Defendant shall file written notice with the Clerk of the Court 24 hours before any change of address.

Because Defendant is charged with a forcible felony, stalking, aggravated stalking, domestic battery, any violation of the Illinois Controlled Substances Act, the Methamphetamine Control and Community Protection Act, or the Cannabis Control Act that is a Class 2 or greater felony, or any felony violation of Article 24 (Deadly Weapons) of the Criminal Code 2012, Defendant shall

(CR1879) surrender all firearms to law enforcement _____ and surrender his or her Firearm Owner's Identification Card to the clerk of the court by _____.

Because Defendant is charged with unlawful use of weapons in or near a school; or in a school conveyance, Defendant shall:

- 1. Submit to a psychological evaluation at the time and place directed by: _____
2. Refrain from entering upon the property of the following school: _____, including any conveyance owned, leased, or contracted by any school to transport students to or from school or a school-related activity, or on any public way within 1,000 feet of real property comprising any school.

Because Defendant is charged with sexual assault or abuse involving a victim under 18 years of age living in the same household with the defendant, Defendant shall:

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Refrain from contact or communication with the alleged child victim _____

Because Defendant is charged with a criminal offense and the victim is a family or household member, Defendant shall:

1. Refrain from contact or communication with the victim: _____
for 72 hours (minimum) or Other _____ following Defendant's release.
2. Refrain from entering or remaining at the victim's residence at: _____
for 72 hours (minimum) or Other _____ following Defendant's release.

Be allowed to enter residence one time with local police escort to remove personal property.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

Defendant is released with the following additional conditions that the court, after considering the factors listed in 725 ILCS 5/110-5(a) and finding that the prosecution has proved by clear and convincing evidence that any condition of release is necessary, determines are "necessary to ensure the defendant's appearance in court, ensure the defendant does not commit any criminal offense, ensure the defendant complies with all conditions of pretrial release, prevent the defendant's unlawful interference with the orderly administration of justice, or ensure compliance with the rules and procedures of problem solving courts. However, conditions shall include the least restrictive means and be individualized. Conditions shall not mandate rehabilitative services unless directly tied to the risk of pretrial misconduct. Conditions of supervision shall not include punitive measures such as community service work or restitution."
